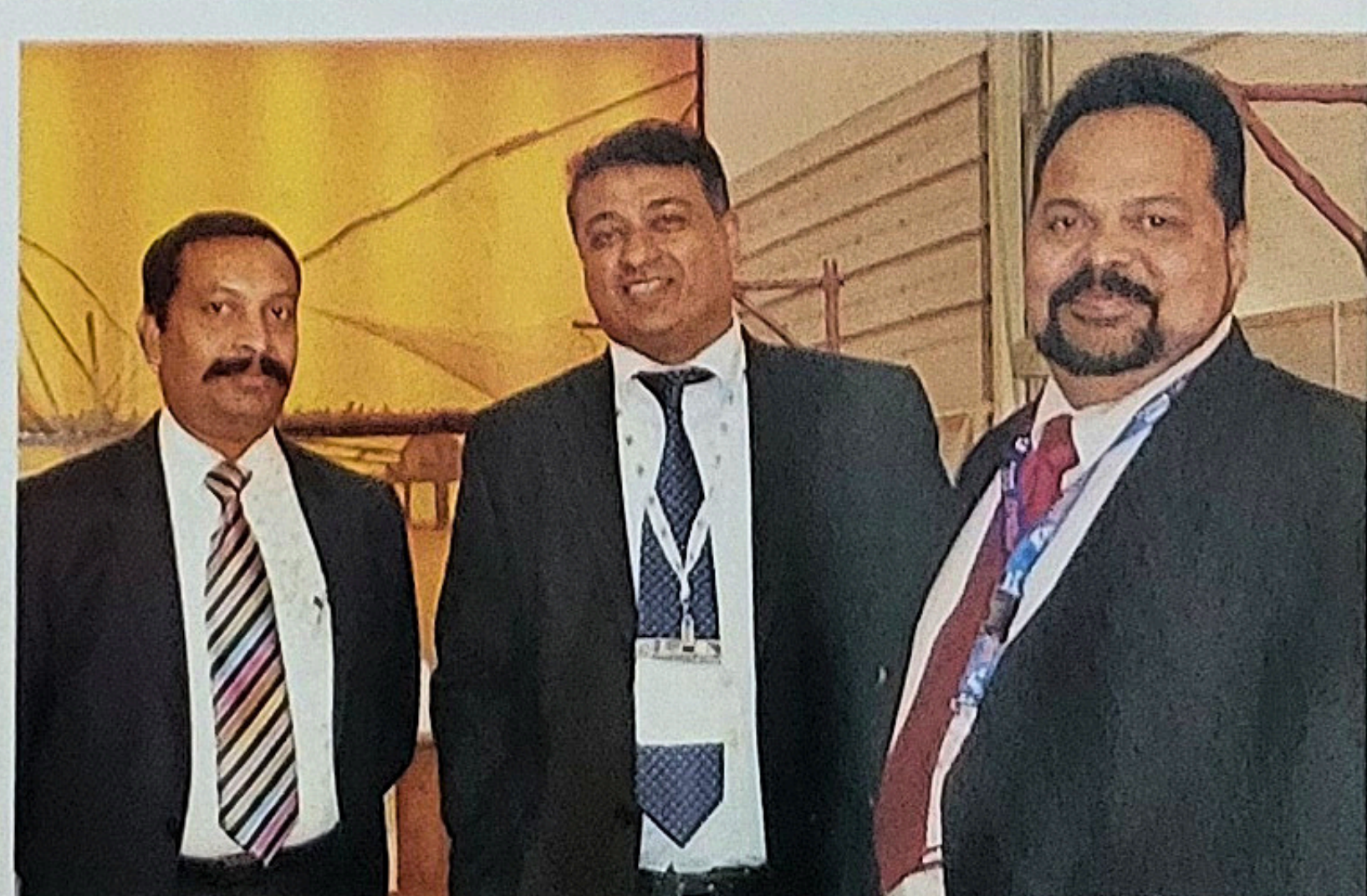
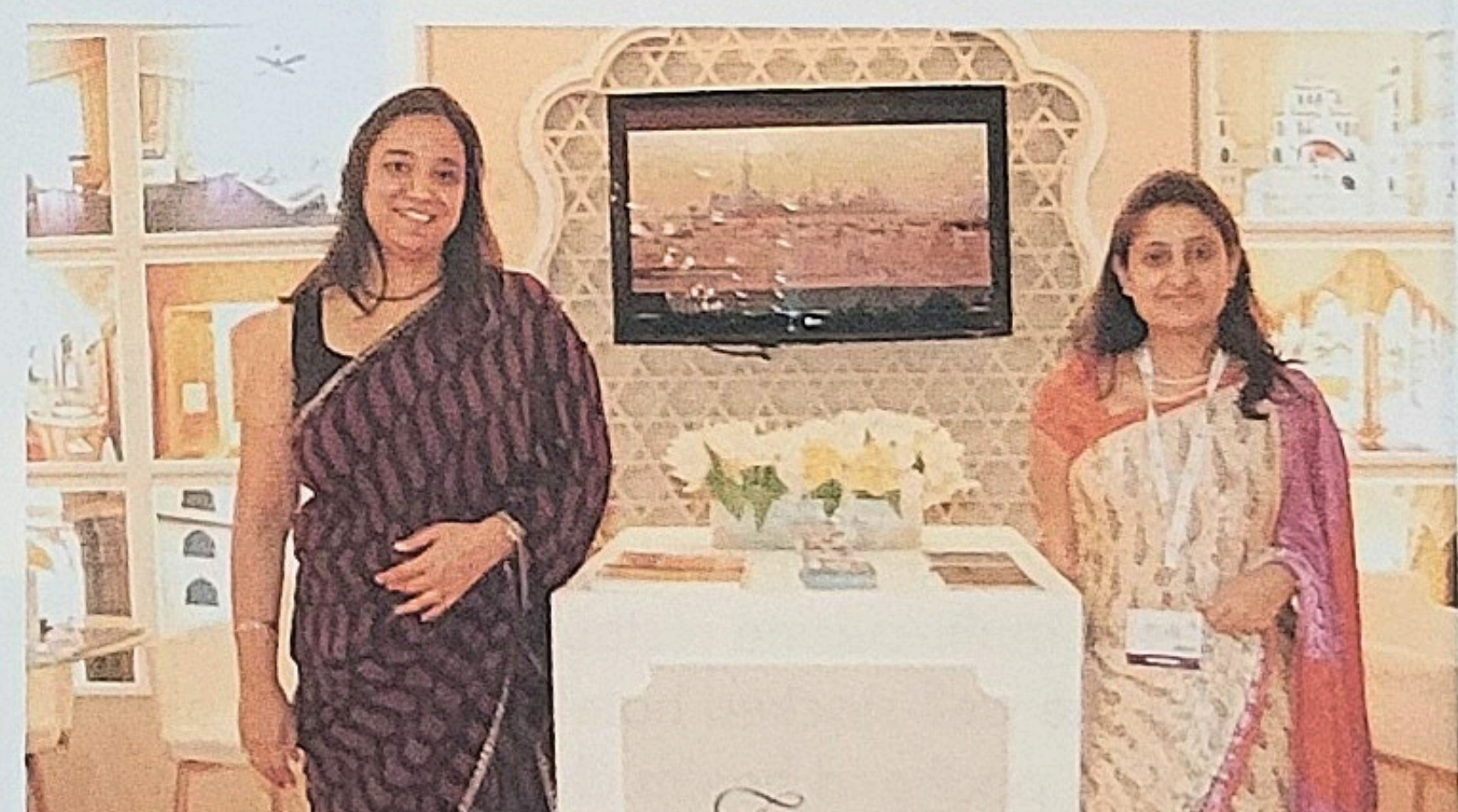
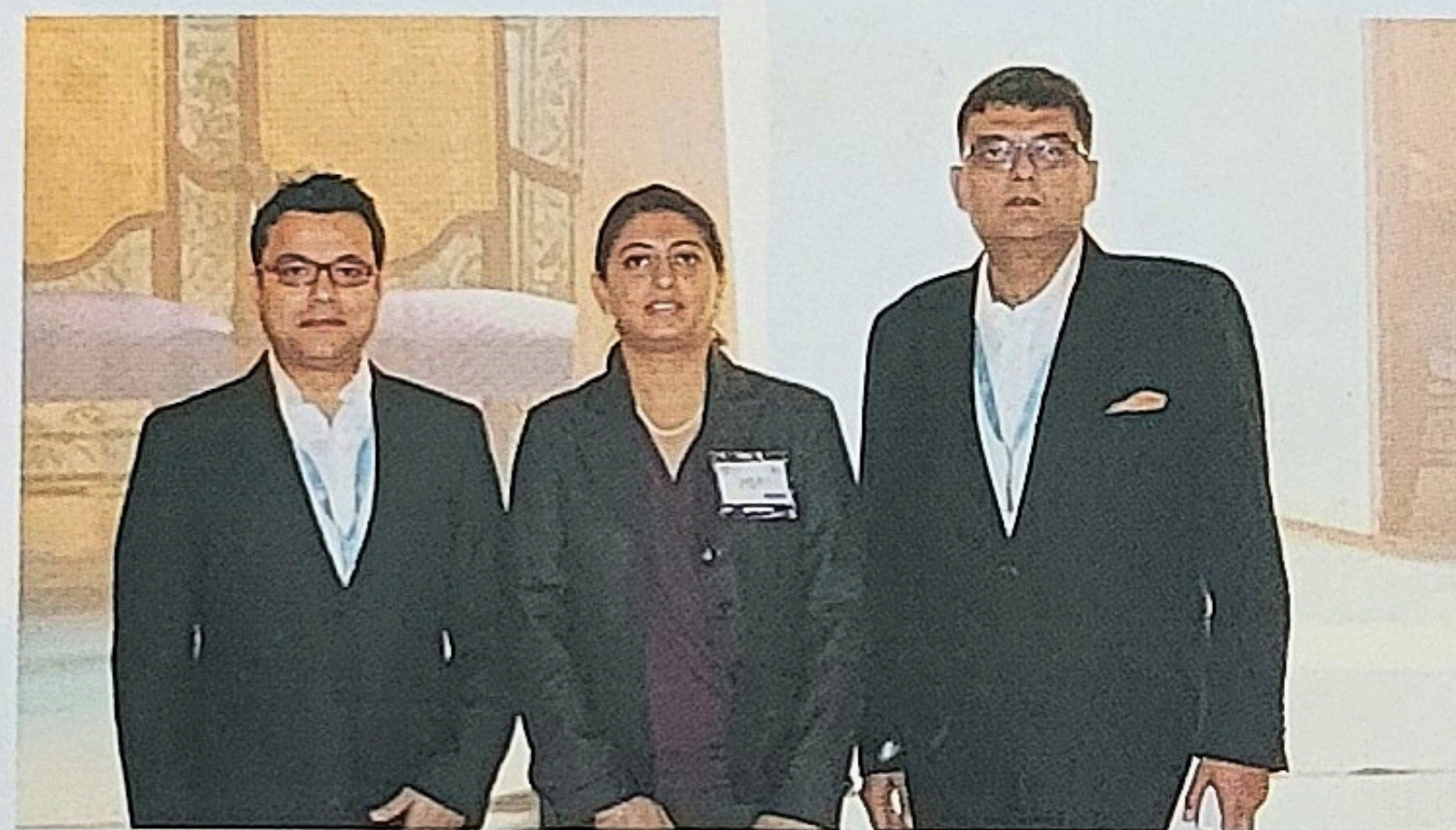
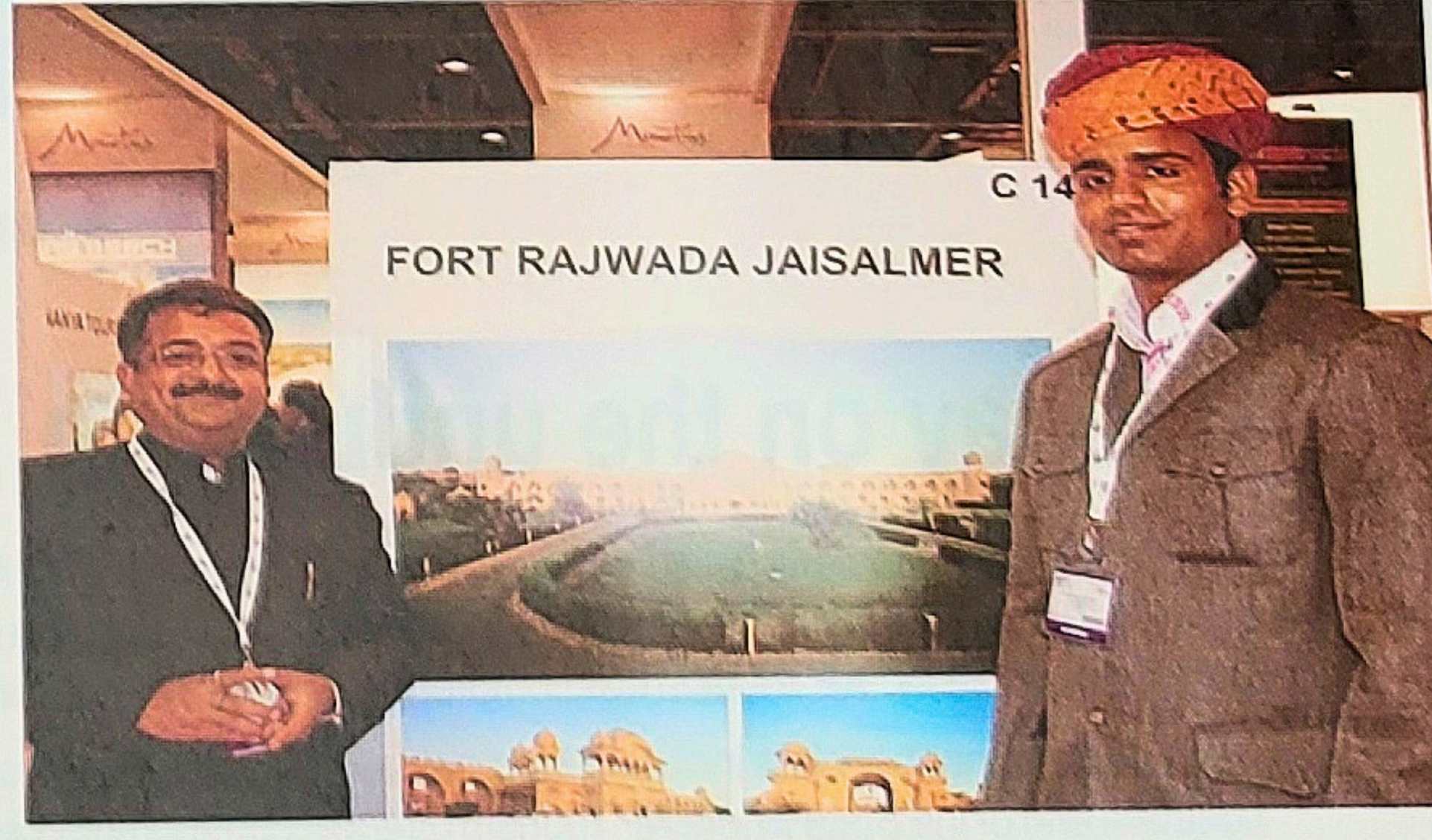
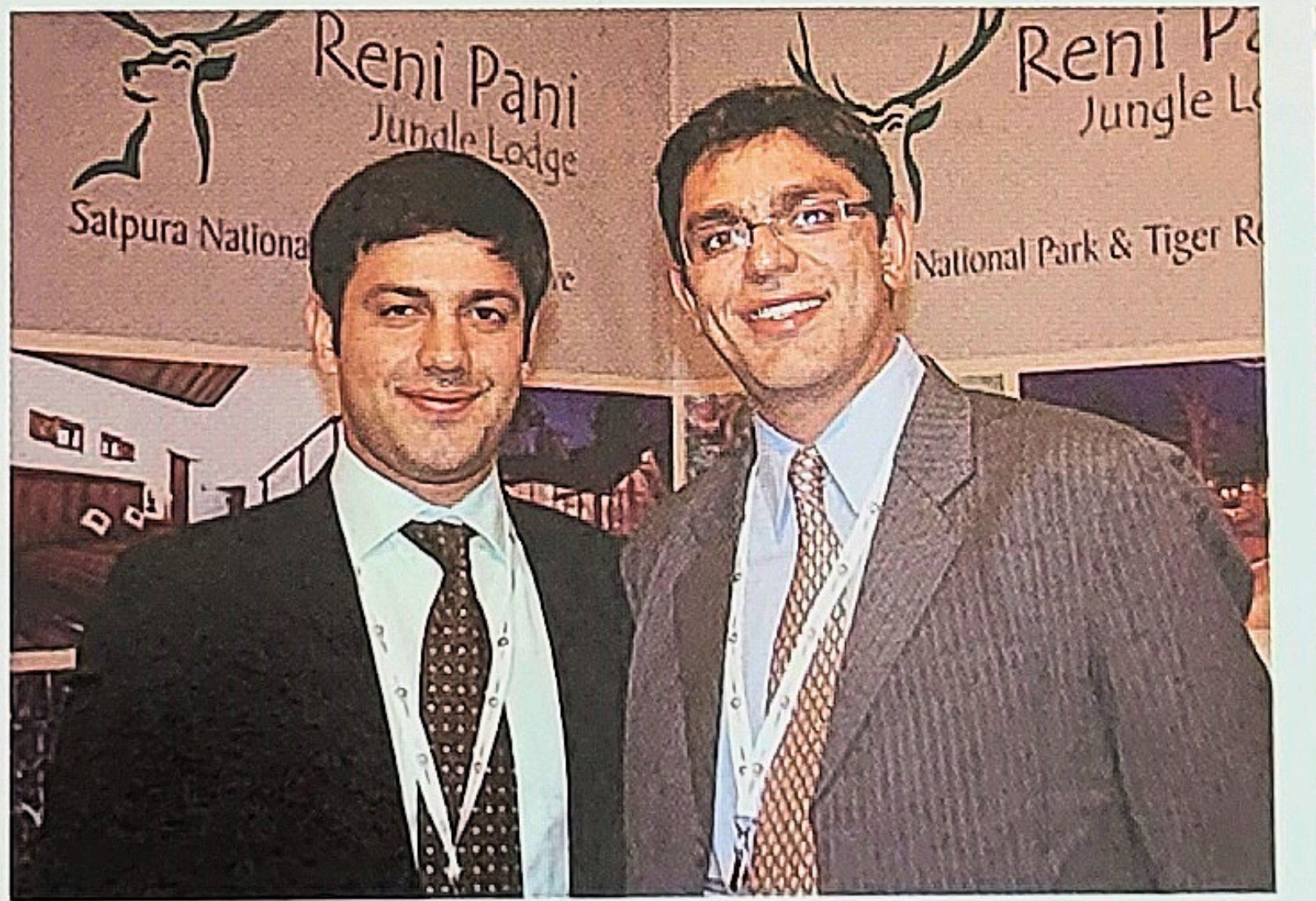
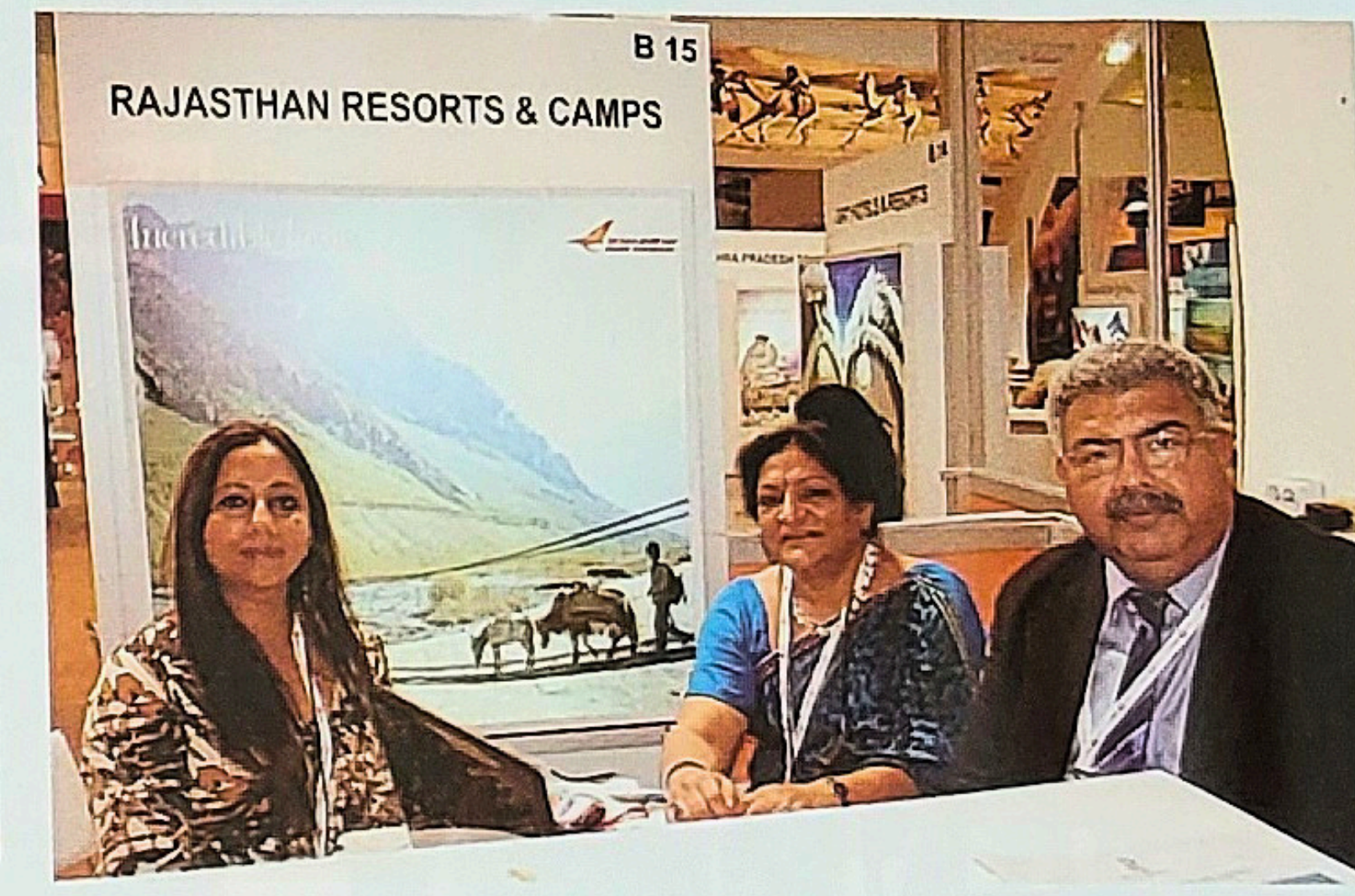
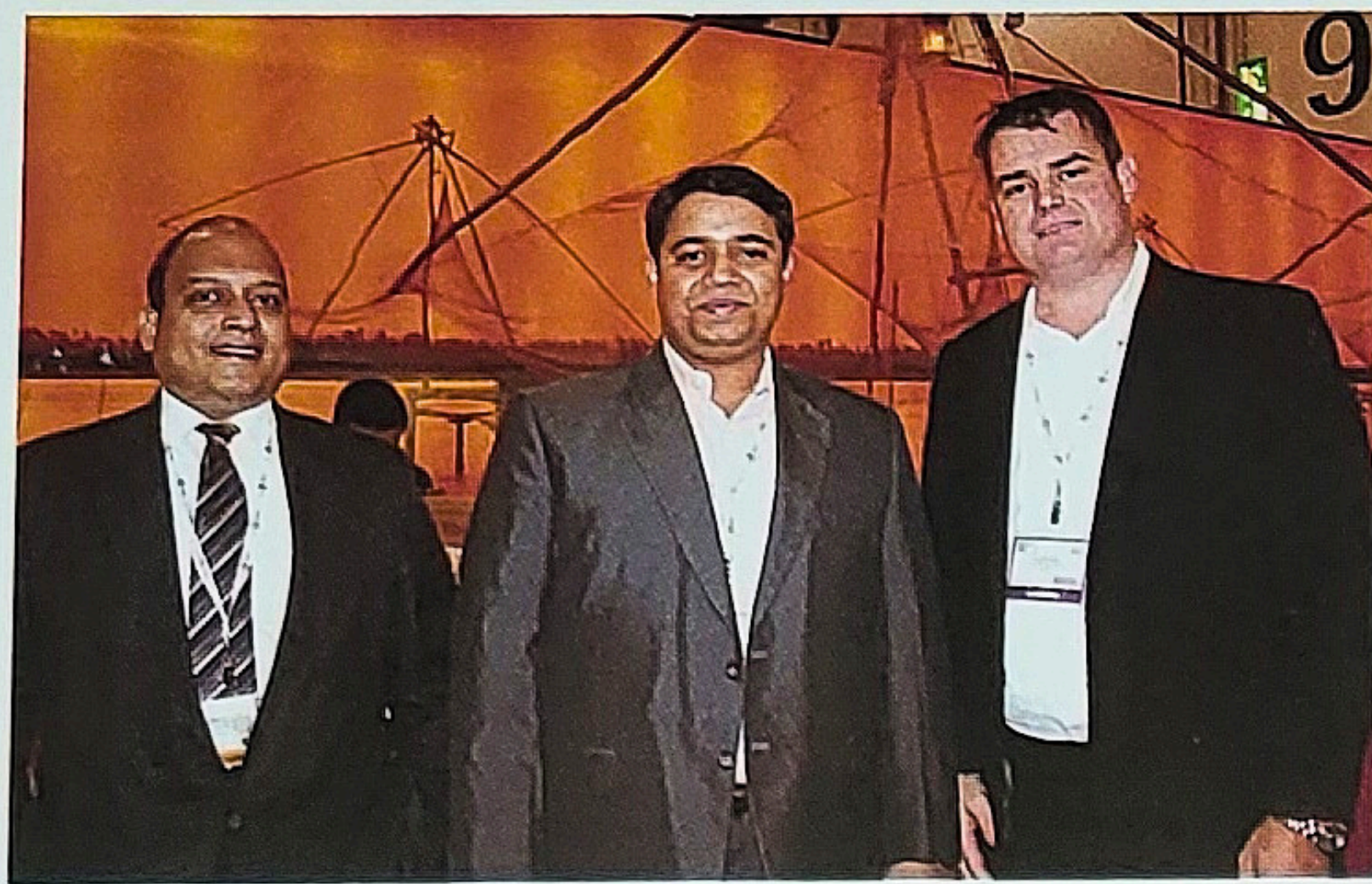


# WTM 2011 opens windows to the world of opportunities

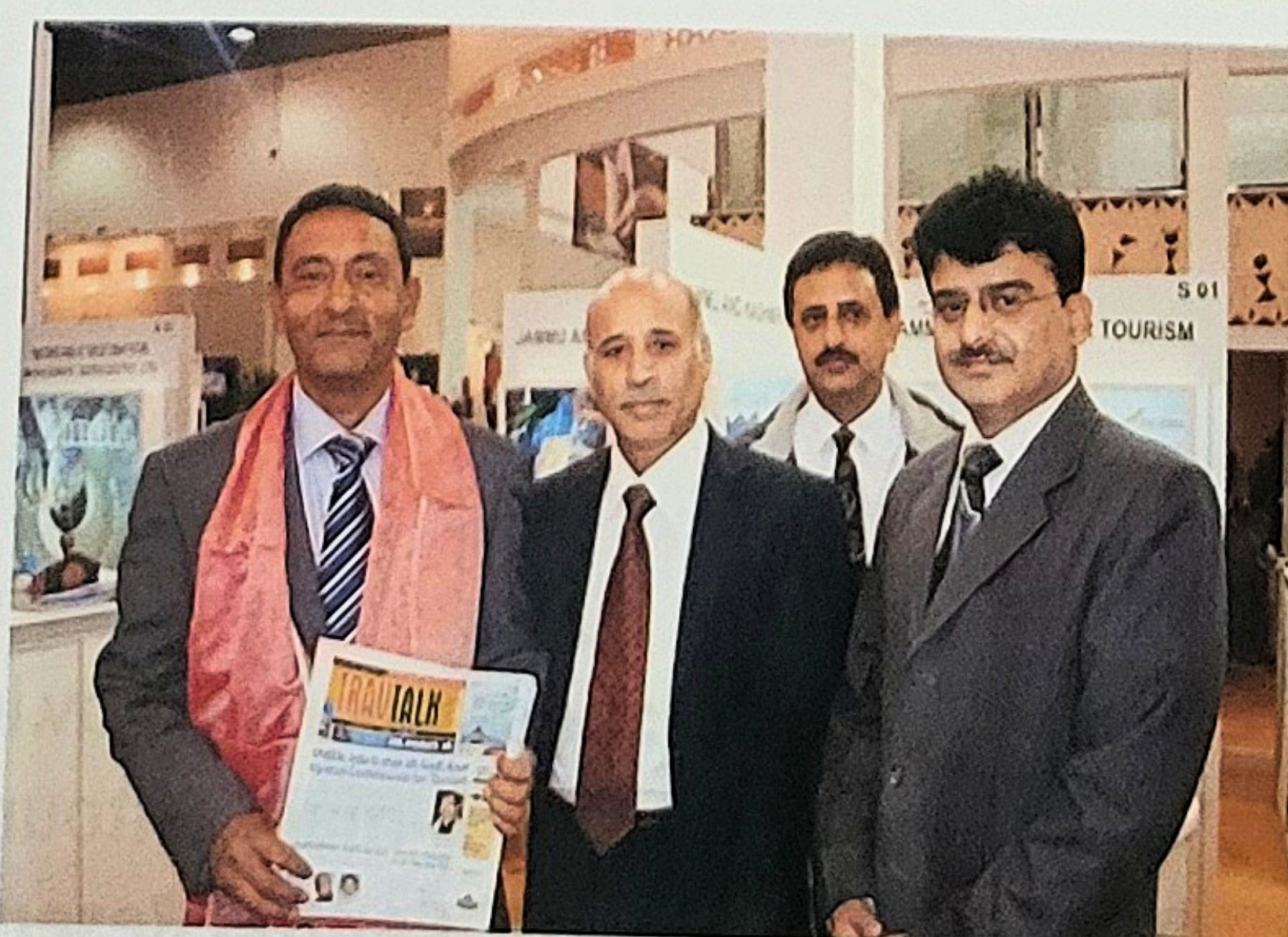
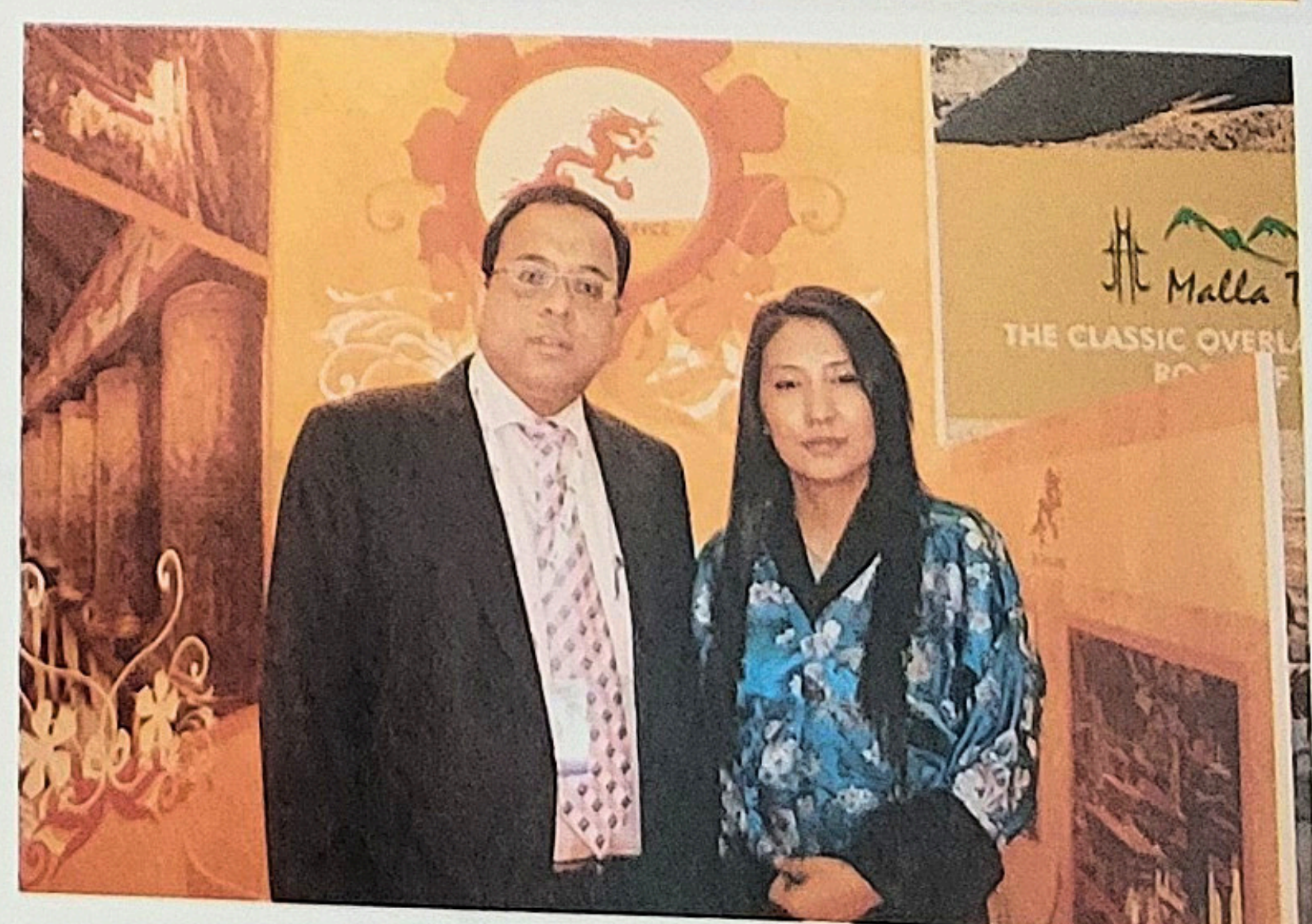
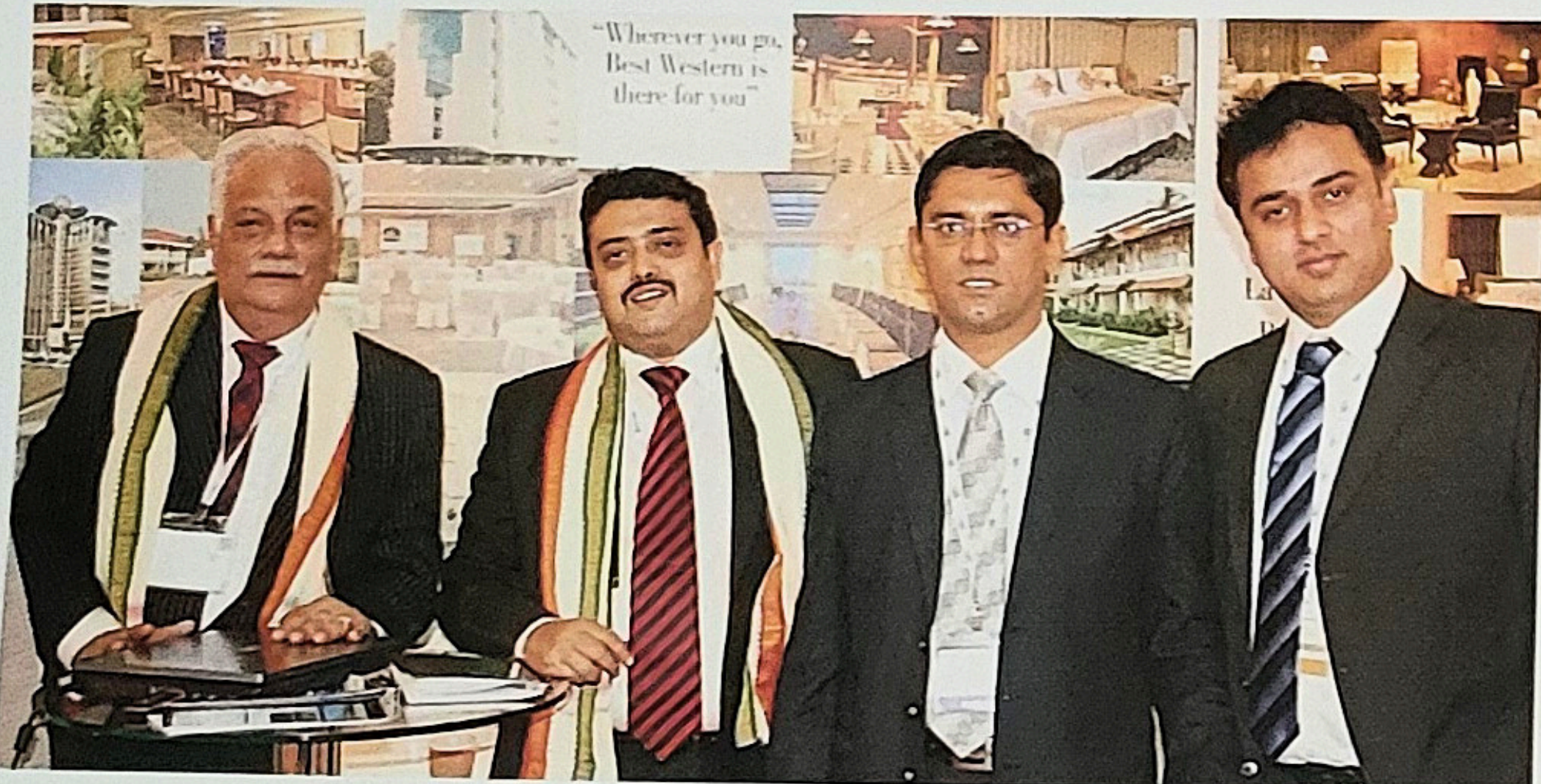
