Delhi mall bags two awards

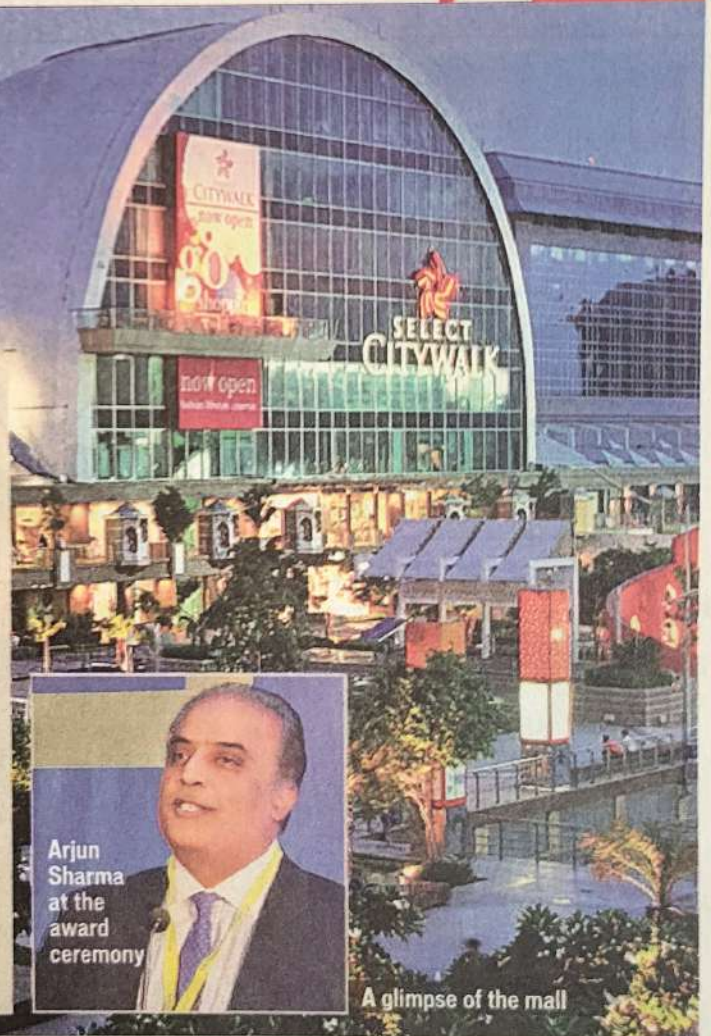
